When measuring the growth of a school or college, one must consider not only the number of students but also the number of classes they are taking. When students study more, they finish their degrees sooner and move on to make an impact on the world through everything they have learned.

We rejoice in the Lord, who allowed us to have 75 course registrations by 39 students in this year's third term. This represents a growth over last year (2018), when we had 58 registrations and 34 students in the same term. The greater number of registrations is in part a result of lower prices, which have made taking a sec-

ond or third class an option for those who had the time to study, but lacked the financial resources to do so.

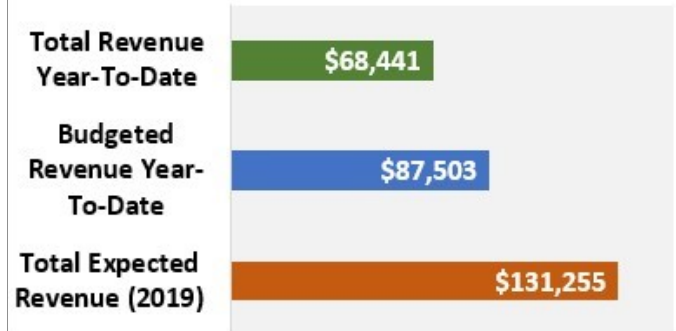
