It was in the Fall of 2009 when I first got in touch with Pastor Ralph Boersema following a notice in one of our church periodicals. He was looking for someone to help out with the IRTC and since I had just retired from my full-time job, I thought I would give it a whirl. Here we are about fifteen years later, and I'm still involved in this ministry, although I've now handed over my duties as the Development Director to Jack Marissen, who is also on the board of the IRTC Society in Canada.

At the time I got involved, there was no Canadian society, so that was one of the first things that kept me busy. It was a bit of a laborious process to get a charitable organization set up in Canada, but we had some good connections which made it possible in a timely manner. Now we were able to issue tax receipts to individual donors and start processing payments from a number of churches, either via their budgets or via separate collections. All this, of course, took a lot of contacts, emails and letters. This was all done in the interest of paying for instructors and administrators of the IRTC, which has been ongoing for many years now and which keeps on growing. In the past few years especially, the number of students has kept increasing and so the need for instructors does also. Thankfully, we've been able to do that with many talented people in different parts of the world.

Initially I did much of the administrative work in Canada by myself, but gradually I was able to recruit some willing and capable board members to help, and there currently are five people on the board. Over the past fifteen years, I was able to develop a good working relationship with Pastor Ralph and his wife Lucille and I treasure that connection to this day. Their dedication to this ministry and the hard work they did was inspirational and kept me going as well. I also got to connect with many others in the organization either face to face or via Zoom calls or correspondence.

I trust that I may have contributed modestly to the work of the IRTC and as we enter the twenty-fifth anniversary year of this online college, I would encourage you to consider becoming a regular supporter (if you are not one already) or asking your
