

Prompte et Sincere: Theological Reflections for the Church and Academia



The latest edition of *Prompte et Sincere* brings together a rich collection of articles that foster theological depth, critical reflection, and Christian edification. Among the highlights, Jônatas Teófilo Louzada Cunha examines the Mosaic Covenant in the Reformed context, arguing that despite varying interpretations, this covenant reveals divine grace and points to the New Covenant in Christ. Charles Melo de Oliveira presents a defense of the Regulative Principle of Worship, emphasizing the sufficiency of Scripture in defining Christian worship and warning against the dangers of liturgical innovations. Rachel van de Burgt explores the foundations of care communication in redemptive pedagogy, encouraging Christian educators to integrate biblical principles of love and discipleship into their teaching practices.

This edition also offers a detailed historical analysis by Marcone Bezerra Carvalho on the *Facultad Evangélica de Teología de Buenos Aires*, which for decades was one of the most significant centers of Protestant theological education in Latin America. Raphael Rocha Quintão examines the concept of theocracy in light of Scripture, discussing its theological and historical implications. In the review section, readers will find analyses of key works, including *Antropologia para missionários* (Anthropology for Missionaries) and *Como se faz um ateu* (How to Make an Atheist). All these articles and reviews are presented with academic rigor and relevance for today's church. The journal is available for free at prompteetsincere.com, and the IRTC plans to publish an English edition later this year.

Our 2024 Graduates: Serving God Around the World


