Growth With Purpose: The IRTC Reaches a New Record in 2025


"The Lord has done great things for us; we are glad." (Psalm 126:3)


With deep gratitude to God, we are pleased to report the results from the first term of 2025: the IRTC reached 273 active students enrolled in 446 courses — the highest figures ever recorded in the institution's history. A comparative chart from 2018 to 2025 reveals consistent growth. Since 2020, this growth has been especially marked, even amid challenging contexts such as the pandemic. This upward trajectory reflects a combination of doctrinal commitment, academic excellence, and accessibility — qualities that have made IRTC a reference point for pastors, missionaries, teachers, leaders, and members of local churches seeking solid biblical training.

More than just numbers, we celebrate lives being shaped, callings being confirmed, and churches being strengthened in the many countries where our students serve — from Brazil to the Middle East, from North America to Portuguese-speaking Africa
